



NOTICE TO CONSUMERS

This Tow Service Provider is contracted with the Massachusetts State Police to provide involuntary towing and related services for Category I operations (light duty, passenger vehicles under 10,000 pound GVWR) to the general public. As such, they are governed by Contractual Language, Department of Public Utilities Regulations, Massachusetts General Laws and by the Code of Massachusetts Regulations, 220 CMR 272,00.

TOW SERVICE PROVIDER: Per contract SP20-TOW-X81, and in accordance with Section 1.2.17, which states "The Tow Service Provider shall conspicuously post therein (of their business location) a reference to 220 CMR 272 as well as maximum rates, charges, and fees associated with involuntary police towing and recovery. Additionally, the Tow Service Provider shall conspicuously post the MSP contact information for filing a towing response. A written copy of both the towing rates and the MSP contact information shall be provided to consumers contemporaneous with the settlement of all outstanding charges, before entering into any private agreements for services, or at any time upon request." Any variance from this requirement will be subject to sanctions under Section 4.2.3.
